

Windows Server - implementing Active Directory services

Course code: GOC220

Five-days instructor-led course covering basics to details of deploying and implementing Active Directory and Group Policy including their mutual requirements with DNS service infrastructure. Students learn all the options available with a primary goal of being able to troubleshoot the function and Group Policy application on computer both locally and remotely. The training also covers the understanding of LDAP database structure, the domains, configuration and schema of a forest. Backup and restore methodology is also an integral part the training.

Preparation for Microsoft certification

This does not mean that official MOC courses would serve as the only necessary preparation. The primary goal of an MOC course is to provide for sufficient theoretical knowledge and practical experience to effectively work with the related product

MOC courses usually cover most of the topics required by their respective certification exams, but often do not give every topic the same amount of time and emphasis as may be required to completely pass the exam
