PRINCE2 Portfolio Management Practitioner is the advanced course focused on the practical application of the MoP framework in a real organisational environment. Participants learn to analyse portfolio data, tailor governance structures, manage benefits realisation, and effectively engage stakeholders at portfolio level. The course is designed for experienced portfolio managers, members of governing bodies, and senior leaders who want to demonstrate the ability to strategically manage and optimise a portfolio of change initiatives. The combination of Foundation and Practitioner certificates qualifies candidates for the PRINCE2 Portfolio Manager designation.

- Tailoring the MoP Framework: How to adapt MoP principles and practices to the specific context of the organisation, the type of portfolio, and the environment in which it operates.
- Portfolio Performance Management: Techniques for measuring and evaluating portfolio performance through KPIs, dashboards, and regular reporting to senior leadership.
- Portfolio Office in Practice: How to establish and run an effective portfolio office as a centre of excellence to support portfolio management across the organisation.
- Case Studies and Scenarios: Practising the application of the framework on real-world portfolio situations as preparation for the open-book Practitioner exam.
