- Six Perspectives: The Strategic, Programme, Project, Operational, Product, and Opportunity perspectives as tools for comprehensive risk assessment.

- People, Culture, and Behaviour: The influence of the human factor, organisational culture, and individual behaviour on the effectiveness of risk management in practice.
- Process Cycle - 8 Processes: Identify, Assess, Plan, Implement, Communicate, Evaluate, Learn, and Embed - ensuring a complete and consistent approach to risk management.
- Identifying and Assessing Critical Risks: Techniques for recognising and evaluating the most critical risks and understanding their collective impact on the likelihood of achieving organisational objectives.
- Response and Contingency Planning: How to select and implement the right risk response strategies and determine the appropriate level of contingency reserves.
- Monitoring, Reporting, and Adapting: Processes for providing timely and insightful updates on risks to decision-makers and evaluating the effectiveness of risk management strategies.
